Thank you for your interest in working with Bar-T Summer Programs for the summer of 2010. Please read this letter and complete the attached JLIT application, making sure to indicate the best date for you to come in for a group interview.

1. All JLITs (first year = Jr. Leader in Training) may be offered a 4-week volunteer position (unpaid position for 4 consecutive weeks). *You must be able to commit to the full four weeks to be considered.*
2. We require that all applicants be entering the 9<sup>th</sup> grade or higher in the fall of 2010.
3. We require that all JLIT (first year) applicants pay a \$50.00 administrative fee.
4. ***Please Note: hours worked as a JLIT are not accepted as Student Service Learning Hours for Montgomery County Public Schools students according to the MCPS SSL policy (company must be Non-Profit)***

As a JLIT (Jr. Leader in Training), you will be exposed to all aspects and areas of the camp. In addition to spending time with an assigned group of campers you will be responsible for various tasks around the camp. Responsibilities will vary between programs, however, daily tasks may include:

- Equipment organization
- Assisting with Arts-n-Crafts, Swimming, and other specialist activities
- Camp Store restocking and staffing
- Helping to ensure that general camp facilities are safe and clean
- Helping to ensure that camp water coolers are fresh and full
- Organizing Lost & Found (and helping to return as much as possible to rightful owners!)
- Assisting our camp office staff

After the group interviews are complete, all candidates will be contacted regarding the status of their application for Bar-T's JLIT program. All candidates that are offered (and accept) a JLIT position must complete all required paperwork prior to the start of camp with our Human Resources Department and attend a pre-camp orientation session.

It is mandatory that JLITs commit to the full 4-week program. The JLIT program dates for the Summer of 2010 are:

JLIT Session 1: June 21<sup>st</sup> – July 16<sup>th</sup>  
JLIT Session 2: July 19<sup>th</sup> – August 13<sup>th</sup>
